




2019 Crime in Montana Summary


Trends in the Number of Index Violent Crimes



Highlights

- Violent Crime ▲ 4.1%
- Violent Crime ▲ 18.3% since 2015
- Rape ▲ 16.7% after a 9.8 ▼ in 2018
- Robberies ▼ 15%
- Aggravated assaults ▲ 4.5% and ▲ 19% since 2015
- Murder and Manslaughter ▼ 7.3% or 3 homicides from 2019

Trends in the Number of Index Property Crimes




Highlights

- \$51,982,705 in stolen, damaged or burned property, a 7% ▼ from 2018
- Total Index Property Crimes ▼ 10.9% and ▼ 12.7% since 2015
- Burglary slight ▼ 11.9% and ▼ 25.1% since 2015
- Motor Vehicle Theft ▼ 16.5%
- Larceny/Theft ▼ 10.1% and ▼ 11.5% from 2015

2019 Substance Abuse Crime Trends


Drug Report Trends



Highlights

- Drug Reports ▲ 15.4% in 2019
- Methamphetamine ▲ 4.6% and ▲ 51.1% from 2015
- Marijuana ▼ 10.1% and the only reported drug type ▼ in 2019
- Opioids/Heroin ▲ 30.2% and ▲ 164.2% since 2015
- Other and Unknown drug types ▲ 39.8%

Driving Under the Influence Arrests Trends



Highlights

- Sheriff and Police data reported separate from Highway Patrol prior to 2017 (data shown is unduplicated)
- Total DUI citations ▼ 1.5% and ▼ 7.1% from 2015
- Sheriff and Police ▲ 1.2% and ▼ 7.4% since 2015
- Highway Patrol ▼ 7% and ▼ 6.5% since 2015
